## **Mike Morse Announces \$1 Million Gift to Michigan Humane**

*Partnership will help programs and services reach the people and pets in metro Detroit*

**(DETROIT – July 19, 2024)** Today, Mike Morse, attorney and founder of the Mike Morse Law Firm, announced a \$1 million gift to Michigan Humane, the state’s oldest and largest animal welfare organization. The funding will help support and raise awareness of Michigan Humane’s community outreach programs, aimed at keeping people and their pets together across metro Detroit.

For almost 150 years, Michigan Humane has been well known for pet adoption.
